



A Proclamation Declaring April 14, 2024 – April 20, 2024 as Public Safety Telecommunications Week in Habersham County

WHEREAS, Communications Officers are a vital link for our police officers, firefighters, and first responders in monitoring their activities by radio, providing them with information, and ensuring their safety; and

WHEREAS, Communications Officers have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, Communications Officers exhibit compassion, understanding, and professionalism while performing their duties.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, the Habersham County Commission duly assembled this 15th day of April, 2024, does hereby proclaim April 14, 2024 through April 20, 2024 as “PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK IN HABERSHAM COUNTY”, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our community and citizens safe.
