PURPOSE: The purpose of this agenda item is to seek approval from the BOC to approve the LMIG 2025 Grant Application.

BACKGROUND / HISTORY: The Local Maintenance Improvement Grant (LMIG) is a grant that Habersham County receives each year from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). The attached 2025 grant application will be for work that is tentatively scheduled for next year. Once approved by the BOC, the application will be sent to GDOT for processing and approval. After approval, GDOT will forward the formula amount we receive, which is \$844,814.79. The attached project summary sheet may be revised once we are ready to put the bid document together for advertisement. As always, the county must match, at minimum, 30% of the formula amount.

- A minimum 30% local match is required
- Local share costs will be funded through SPLOST VII
- The current proposed project value is estimated to cost \$2,179,800.00
- Of the total project cost, the local share will be \$1,334,985.21
