SEFCCOs' service to Habersham County, GA

A brief history from first contact to today.

• SEFCCO was contacted by officials of Habersham County, GA in August of 2024, regarding the possible consolidation of one or more municipal fire department(s) into the county fire system.

 We affirmed that this is a project that we can be of service and started compiling information for our proposal.

 SEFCCO attended a meeting in Clarksville on October 28th 2024. We met with officials from Habersham County and the City of Demorest to discuss issues concerning consolidation.

SEFCCOs' service to Habersham County, GA

A brief history from first contact to today.

- SEFCCO attended a second meeting in Demorest on November 21st 2024. This was called with the municipal representatives and Habersham County representatives so that we could answer questions regarding the process of exploring consolidation of fire services.
- Following the November 21st meeting, all interested municipalities signed a resolution of interest to take part in the Fire Services Consolidation Study. At this point, we prepared our proposal as we now have the scope of work.

Clarksville

SEFCCO's charge for service

 We listed our charge for service in the contract between SEFCCO and Habersham County, GA.

• The base charge for service is \$ 30.000.00

The charge for each participating municipality is \$ 5,000.00 x 5 participants

 The total charge for the scope of work as outlined in the contract is \$ 55,000.00

SEFCCO's charge for service

• The 55,000.00 charge is broken down into twelve monthly payments of \$4,583.33 per month.

• Breaking the payments down into monthly increments creates a pay as we go atmosphere. Our clients are able to see progress which builds confidence in the process.

What we do during this process...

As part of this process, SEFCCO will provide consultation to Habersham County for preparation of the next ISO/Verisk Public Protection Classification (PPC).

As part of this process, we will return when Habersham County goes through its next PPC Survey.

This does not extend to the individual municipalities.

What we do during this process...

- At the end of this process, we will create a report on the consolidation of fire services within Habersham County, GA.
- Our report will include comments regarding the individual municipalities, IE; Does it benefit them to consolidate?
- This report will be created at the end of the contract period following research, assessment and computations of information.

EXIT CLAUSE

• SEFCCO will add an EXIT CLAUSE in the contract. If the Government of Habersham County has the opinion that SEFCCO is not living up to the performance which is stated in our contract, the contract can be terminated with a 30-day written notice. This EXIT CLAUSE can be executed by either party (Habersham County or SEFCCO).
